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**I. Call to Order:**

Without a quorum present, Chair Ijaz Ahmed called the meeting of the Butler Chain of Lakes Advisory Board (Advisory Board) to order at 5:40 P.M.

**II. Approval of the July 17, 2017 Meeting Agenda:**

There was no quorum to approve the agenda.

**III. Approval of the June 19, 2017 Regular Meeting Minutes:**

**IV. Public Comment on Propositions Before the Advisory Board:**

Mr. Roger Fielding and Mr. Steven Wrigley of Orlando Lake Tours were recognized and gave an overview of their tour boat operation on the Butler Chain of Lakes. They both expressed concern over observations of increased use and misuse of the lakes in the Chain by personal water craft (PWC) or "Jet Ski" operators. They mentioned that they picked up their passengers at the R.D. Keene boat ramp on Lake Isleworth and, in doing so, have observed PWC operators apparently speeding and operating the water craft in erratic fashion. They jointly suggested that a "No Wake Zone" designation may be appropriate for this area.

### **1. Current Projects**

David Hansen reported that the Lake Down Sub-Basin 9 baffle box had been slightly modified to improve the flow of water through it. He also mentioned that the \$95,000 cost share grant for construction of the baffle box had been received from the South Florida Water Management District.

Mr. Hansen reported that the Operation and Maintenance (O & M) contract for the Lake Down Alum Facility was nearing completion. He also mentioned that a Request for Proposal for interim O & M service had been submitted and accepted. He reported that the County Facilities Division may be taking over some maintenance (building repair, mowing, etc.) at the facility.

Mr. Hansen mentioned that he had requested that the Bay Hill outfall to Lake Tibet be put on the current water quality sampling rotation by the Water Sciences Division. Lori Bradford mentioned that high Total Phosphorus levels attributed to reclaimed water usage on the Bay Hill golf course was reported in Dr. Harvey Harper's 2010 study.

Mr. Hansen reported that the proposal for the Wauseon Bay bathymetric survey was being updated to address comments from Vice Chair Lloyd Woosley.
