Welcome

Dr. Sylvia T. Caceres called the meeting to order at 8:34 a.m. and addressed the housekeeping issues including the meeting being open to the public under the Sunshine Law.

Approval of Minutes

Public Comment

There were no members of the public present at the Board meeting.

Lift Orlando

Dr. Sylvia T. Caceres introduced Mr. Eddy Moratin, Executive Director of Lift Orlando. Mr. Moratin presented his colleagues and introduced a video to explain the mission of Lift Orlando. Lift Orlando has spearheaded the redevelopment of the neighborhood surrounding Camping World Stadium into what will be The Westlakes Community, a mixed-income, purpose-built area. Mr. Moratin took questions from the Board and Citizens' Commission for Children staff, further explaining Lift Orlando's goals.

Strategic Plan Update

Ms. Mary Davis, Sr. Monitoring and Evaluation Coordinator directed Board members to the CCC Strategic Planning Stakeholder Survey Results which indicated that the Division's goals are seen by Board Members and community stakeholders as relevant, in the majority. Ms. Davis explained that the CCC is utilizing results in refining strategic goals and setting the objectives of the Citizens' Commission for Children Strategic Plan beginning in 2018. The Board will continue to receive updates from staff as the process moves forward.

CCC Updates

Ms. Danna Jackson-Carroll, Sr. Program Manager, informed the Board that the Professional Opportunities Program for Students (POPS) Summer Internship has begun as coordinated by After School Zone staff. The Quality Assurance team has just begun the summer evaluations of the 13 NCFs. Evaluations. The Union Park Neighborhood Center for Families location move has been put on hold for the moment. Discussions are still ongoing and the move is still possible in the future. The Summer Zone is well underway at 20 of the After School Zone Orange County Middle School sites. The Board was then directed to several pieces of information in their meeting packets, including the annual Kids Count Data Book. Follow-up on summer programming and monitoring will be provided to the Board Members at the next CCC Advisory Board Meeting.

Dr. Sylvia T. Caceres led general Board discussion and CCC staff answered questions.
