I. Meeting Called to Order:

With a quorum present, Chairman Lionel Robbins called the meeting of the Lake Holden Advisory Board (Advisory Board) to order at 5:30 p.m.

II. Approval of the September 27, 2017 Meeting Minutes:

Upon a Motion by Mike Powell, seconded by Rick Richbourg, and carried with all present members voting AYE by voice vote, with Caroline St. Clair and Dana Kruetzfeldt being absent; the meeting minutes for September 27, 2017 were approved as submitted.

III. Public Comment:

Chairman Robbins opened the floor for public comment. Hearing no request, the public comment period was closed.

IV. Environmental Protection Division (EPD) Report:

Surface Water Elevation

Melissa Lavigne provided an update on water levels after Hurricane Irma. The Advisory Board stated the lake level was approximately 2 inches above normal high water elevation and the drainwell sleeves had been replaced on October 13, 2017.

Wood Duck Boxes

Lionel Robbins received permission from the property owner for Rick Fender to install wood duck nesting boxes on the larger, central island. Lionel Robbins displayed pictures of the installed boxes.

Water Sports

Melissa Lavigne stated she had reached out to Water Sports Industry Association to ask about setting up a meeting for wakeboarders and other interested parties to discuss courteous boating practices and considerations during high water levels.

Curb Inlet Basket Report

Melissa Lavigne reported information on Lake Holden's curb inlet basket program, as follows:

- Original number of basket locations in the Lake Holden drainage basin: 115
- Currently installed: 99
- Need to be replaced due to damage (or permanently pulled due to flooding concerns): 16
- Debris removal totals for fiscal year 2016: 35,399 lbs
- Average weight of debris removed per basket in 2016: 31.2 lbs
- Debris removal totals for fiscal year 2017 (to date): 32,400 lbs
- Average weight of debris removed per basket in 2017: 30.8 lbs
