I. Meeting Called to Order:

With a quorum present, Chairman Lionel Robbins called the meeting of the Lake Holden Advisory Board (Advisory Board) to order at 5:30 p.m.

II. Approval of the January 17, 2018 Meeting Minutes:

Upon a Motion by Mike Powell, seconded by Rick Richbourg, and carried with all present members voting AYE by voice vote; the meeting minutes for January 17, 2018 were approved as submitted.

III. Public Comment:

Chairman Robbins opened the floor for public comment. Hearing no request, the public comment period was closed.

IV. Environmental Protection Division (EPD) Report:

43rd Street Stormwater Pond Retrofit Analysis and Design:

Melissa Lavigne discussed Geosyntec's revised 43rd St Pond Proposal which was forwarded to the Advisory Board on February 13, 2018 for review. Significant revisions were made to the scope to address comments from the Advisory Board during January's meeting. The cost was reduced from \$69,932.87 to \$27,767.28. Discussion ensued.

Upon a Motion by Mike Powell, seconded by Rick Richbourg, with Vice Chair Caroline St. Clair, Mike Powell, Rick Richbourg, and Dana Kruetzfeldt voting AYE by voice vote and Chairman Lionel Robbins voting NAY by voice vote; the Advisory Board approved an expenditure not to exceed \$32,000 (\$27,767.28 plus contingency for post design services) for the 43rd Street Stormwater Pond Retrofit Analysis and Design.
