#### Dana Kruetzfeldt

- Discussed her observations of areas of the lake including stormwater outfalls and canals, and expressed concern with vegetation and trash. She also spoke about the possibility of a lake cleanup committee.

## **Chairman Lionel Robbins**

- Distributed a hand-drawn map from 1980 of the obsolete aeration system on Lake Holden. He discussed details of the project and encouraged the Advisory Board to always consider spending money for expert opinion/review on projects to help determine the best path forward.
- Reported on a successful meeting with the Water Sports Industry Association (WSIA), a few wakeboard professionals, Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) Law Enforcement, and some members of the Lake Holden Property Owners Association. In an effort to continue open communication with all parties, they formed the "Lake Holden Water Sports Community" group. They

plan to work on signage and handbooks for courteous boating/recreation and assign point persons for water sports-related complaints.
