#### **Meeting Notes**

#### Commission on Aging Status Update

- The Board asked for an update on the membership of the Commission on Aging. Ms. Reggentin stated she discussed the lack of quorum and absenteeism rates with the MMRB staff after the March meeting. The Board noted that Mr. Bohannon was rotating off the Board and a new board chair would need to be elected. However, a new chair could not be elected since a quorum was not present.
- Mr. Martinez provided an update on the Commission on Aging. Recent activities including the release of new Orange TV segments and a symposium on understanding recent federal and state healthcare and aging policy changes. Upcoming events include the 50+ FYI Expo at the Renaissance Senior Center on June 1, the next quarterly training for Elder Ambassadors on June 4 and the World Elder Abuse Awareness Day event on June 15 at the Community United Methodist Church in Casselberry.

## New Business / Open Discussion
