Opening Ceremonies

Hurricane Update 2018

He shared stats from Hurricane Florence and talked about the response actions taking place for Hurricane Michael.

Mr. Durden briefed that Volunteer Florida lost most of its funds this year for Citizen Corps and CERT grants for the state. He mentioned that Volunteer Florida only received \$120,000 total for the year to cover both grants. Mr. Durden let the council know that they received \$5,000 for CERT and \$0.00 for Citizen Corps.

The Council voted unanimously to cancel the November meeting. The meeting was scheduled the day before Thanksgiving. The meeting will resume in December.
