OBTD Development Board’s Policy concerning Public Comment:

Members of the public may address the OBTDDB regarding propositions before this Board. Anyone who wishes to speak should complete a speaker’s form and return it to the staff. Public comment is taken at the end of the meeting. If members of the public are speaking on the same topic, each person is given three minutes to speak. If speaking on different topics, each person is given five minutes to speak.

Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, states that if a person decides to appeal any decision made by a board, agency, or commission with respect to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
