3.	Manager's Report	John Goodrich stated that the search for a new Manager of Animal Services and new Assistant Manager of Animal Services continues.
		Goodrich announced a new series of billboard advertisements appearing in Orange County.
		Lisa Franchina requested an update on the status of the new shelter. Goodrich explained that an internal county meeting is pending to discuss the site of the new building. Once that decision is made, the architect can begin design.
		Due to the recent heat wave, improvements are being made to building 300 which houses most of the dogs. These improvements include painting the roof and possibly adding insulation.
