Chair Shelby Norwich called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm

Public Comment & Introductions

All introduced themselves. Jan Addison is new to the Public Art Review Board. Norwich asked for public comment. There were none.

Consent Agenda

Upon a motion by Donna Dowless and second by Carolyn Fennell the following items were unanimously approved.

- c. Selection of a Dorothy Gillespie sculpture from her Rockefeller exhibition for the 2018-19 Sculpture on the Lawn exhibition.

2. Old Business

- a. East Orange Regional Park public art: Olson reported that the building will have an opening on Tuesday, April 2.
- b. I-4 Ultimate Project: None of the jurisdictions have received word about their public art allocations. Shannon will check with the City of Orlando to see if they have heard anything. Olson will check with the SGL liaison.

New Business*

- a. Coralie showed images of a proposed exhibition from the Orlando Museum of Art. Upon a motion by Kevin Haran and second by Carolyn Fennell, the exhibition was unanimously approved for the next *Art in the Chambers* exhibition.
- b. Olson asked if there was a theme the Review Board would like for the 2019 Sculpture on the Lawn. There was consensus that no theme would be needed.
- c. Staff: There was concern expressed that the amount of public art related duties for Orange County would be best handled by a full-time public art manager. Chair Norwich offered to write a letter on behalf of the Public Art Review Board encouraging Orange County to consider adding such a position.
