

Disability Advisory Board Meeting October 8, 2018

The meeting of the Orange County Disability Advisory Board (DAB) was called to order at 2:10 p.m. on Monday October 8, 2018, at 2100 E. Michigan St., Second Floor ABC Conference Room, Orlando, FL. 32806. Chairperson Sandra Algarin opened the meeting and proceeded to call roll. Board members present: Chairperson Sandra Algarin, Karolyn Campbell, Daisy Morales, Joe Waczewski, and Beverly Jackson. Orange County Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Program Manager Karen Ashmeade was also in attendance. Board Members not present: Vice Chairperson Kirk Root, Theresa Smith and Dyolena Jules. Eric & Amanda Varmuza (Tampa, FL) of On-Time Transports spoke on raising awareness for morbidly obese members of the community that must be transported via stretchers. Many times these citizens miss important appointments (doctors, dentist, etc.) because the facility is not equipped to accommodate them.
