43rd Street Stormwater Pond Retrofit – Construction Complete

Melissa Lavigne relayed that the contractor, Uribe Site Development, reached final completion of the project on Tuesday, September 10, 2019. The engineer of record, Geosyntec Consultants, has reviewed and certified the as-built plans and submitted to SJRWMD to satisfy permit conditions. The as-builts were distributed.
