2.	Approval of Minutes	August minutes were approved
3.	Manager's Report	Diane Summers gave the manager's report. A highlight of the report was the 96% live release rate for dogs.
4.	Old business	<p>Paul Wean read an update regarding current legislative topics involving animals. He reiterated his opinion that new legislation needs to be enacted in Orange county regarding back yard breeding.</p> <p>Summers pointed out that due to COVID19 restrictions, the county and state politicians may be less amenable at this time to pressure for new legislation.</p> <p>Summers agreed to follow up with Palm Beach County in reference to their regulations for back yard breeders.</p>
5.	New Business	<p>Janet Williams asked if it was possible for Orange County to arrange rabies vaccinations for persons who routinely work with feral cats.</p> <p>Peggy Meeks stated it is unlikely that Orange County would offer these vaccinations due to the high cost and low availability of the drugs involved.</p>
