### Minutes

- Ms. Reggentin opened the meeting and thanked everyone for attending.
- Ms. Reggentin stated the goal for today's meeting was to complete the first pass through the draft document. Then the next meeting would allow an opportunity to review a completely revised draft.
- The Committee began to review the draft *Community Resources for Elders* document. Discussion ensued. The following recommendations were made.
  - Where possible, lists of resources should be converted into tables and the text should be bulleted.
  - The provider information for the lead agencies should be in a table format. Bullets should list the lead agency functions as well as the additional programming each agency offers.
  - Ms. Roman will review the pages on Medicare, Medicaid and the Affordable Care Act.
  - In the continued learning section, reference should be made to the network of cooperative extension agencies.
  - The Orange County Government should be reorganized and categorized by type of service. Services offered by the Constitutional Officers should be blending with Orange County Board of County Commissioner services.
  - Staff is working on a disclaimer statement that will be added to the table of contents.
