(a)(1)(i)....The environmental protection officer may approve variances to the provisions of this ordinance to accommodate persons with disabilities or to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act. This item will be placed on the Agenda for the October 26, 2016 EPC Meeting. Motion passes unanimously.
