Meeting Notes

- Mr. Bohannon summarized the purpose of this special meeting is to discuss the content for a letter to the County expressing the Board's concern regarding the reduction of programming for elders.
- The Board discussed whether this letter should be directed to County administration or the Board of County Commissioners. Discussion ensued. The Board asked staff for the structure of County administration and the organizational chart as it relates to the Commission on Aging. It was decided the letter should go to County administration and should reference the Board's intent to discuss the issue with the Board of County Commissioners.
- The Board discussed the content of the letter. It was agreed that the letter should reference
 the demographic shift and rising elder population, the strong momentum in programming for
 elders that has occurred since the Board was created and the adverse impact a reduction in
 programming will have on this momentum. The Board expressed a reduction in
 programming was 'unacceptable.'

- The Board discussed the timing of this letter. Mr. Bohannon asked staff where the County was in the budget cycle. Ms. Reggentin responded that she did not know the public hearing dates for approval, but the proposed budget was still under review. It was agreed this letter should be sent while the County is still in the review process for the fiscal year 2016/17 budget.
- The Board discussed the process of writing this letter. The Board directed Mr. Bohannon to send the letter, with a copy to staff and instructions to distribute to the entire Commission on Aging.
- Mr. Bohannon asked staff to send him the contact information for County administration.
