**Minutes**

- Welcome - Ms. Gendron opened the meeting and thanked everyone for attending.
- Minutes – Upon a motion by Ms. Nix, seconded by Ms. Hauser Burnett, the minutes of May 3, 2016 were unanimously approved.
- Presentation – “How Financial Institutions Help Protect Elders from Potential Exploitation,” Crockett Bohannon, Raymond James. Mr. Bohannon gave a disclaimer that this presentation reflected his experiences as a financial planner and should not be considered financial advice. Mr. Bohannon provided a summary of the scope and impact of financial exploitation and identity theft in the United States. He also overviewed many of the services provided to clients by their financial entities.
- Commission on Aging Update – Ms. Gendron stated the LIFE Information for Elders seminar series for Fall 2016 has been released. The series has been downsized from

three locations each month to one location due to a reduction in staffing. The Elder Ambassador program was also placed on hiatus to better align projects to existing staff resources.
