I. Meeting Called to Order:

With a quorum present, Chairman Lionel Robbins called the meeting of the Lake Holden Advisory Board (Advisory Board) to order at 5:39 p.m.

II. Approval of the March 15, 2017 Meeting Minutes:

Upon a Motion by Rick Richbourg, seconded by Mike Powell, and carried with all present members voting AYE by voice vote; the meeting minutes for March 15, 2017 were approved as submitted.

III. Public Comment:

Chairman Robbins opened the floor for public comment. Hearing no request, the public comment period was closed.

IV. Environmental Protection Division (EPD) Report:

Aquatic Plant Management

Melissa Lavigne reported that EPD performed block treatments of *Hydrilla verticillata* in the north and southwest portions of the lake on March 31, 2017. Spot treatments were performed on April 12, 2017. Pondweed will continue to be monitored.

MSTU Budget Report

Melissa Lavigne provided the following budget report:

- Lake Holden MSTU Account Balance as of April 19, 2017 = \$686,054
- Annual Taxes Collected To Date = \$123,841 (anticipated \$135,000 for 2017)

Stormwater Pond Retrofits – Feasibility Evaluation

Melissa Lavigne conveyed that Geosyntec Consultants prepared a scope of services and fee proposal for Phase I of the Westmoreland Pond and 43^{rd} St Pond Improvement Projects. The proposal was sent to the Advisory Board members in advance for review. Total Price = \$113,728.85. Discussion ensued.

Upon a Motion by Mike Powell, seconded by Rick Richbourg, and carried with all present members voting AYE by voice vote; the Advisory Board approved an expenditure of funds not to exceed \$40,000 for only the 43rd Street Pond Improvement Project.

Alum Treatment System Recommendations

Melissa Lavigne reported that conversations had begun with the City of Orlando regarding alum treatment system operation and dosing rates. The County and City plan to meet in May 2017.

- Offered an idea to appoint a community liaison to relay Advisory Board business throughout the Lake Holden MSTU. The liaison could also attend other advisory board meetings to discuss lake-related concerns and form a network.

- Discussed historical hydrologic connections between Lake Holden and other waterbodies, such as Lake Jennie Jewel. He is interested in the reason the connections were lost and drainwells were added.
