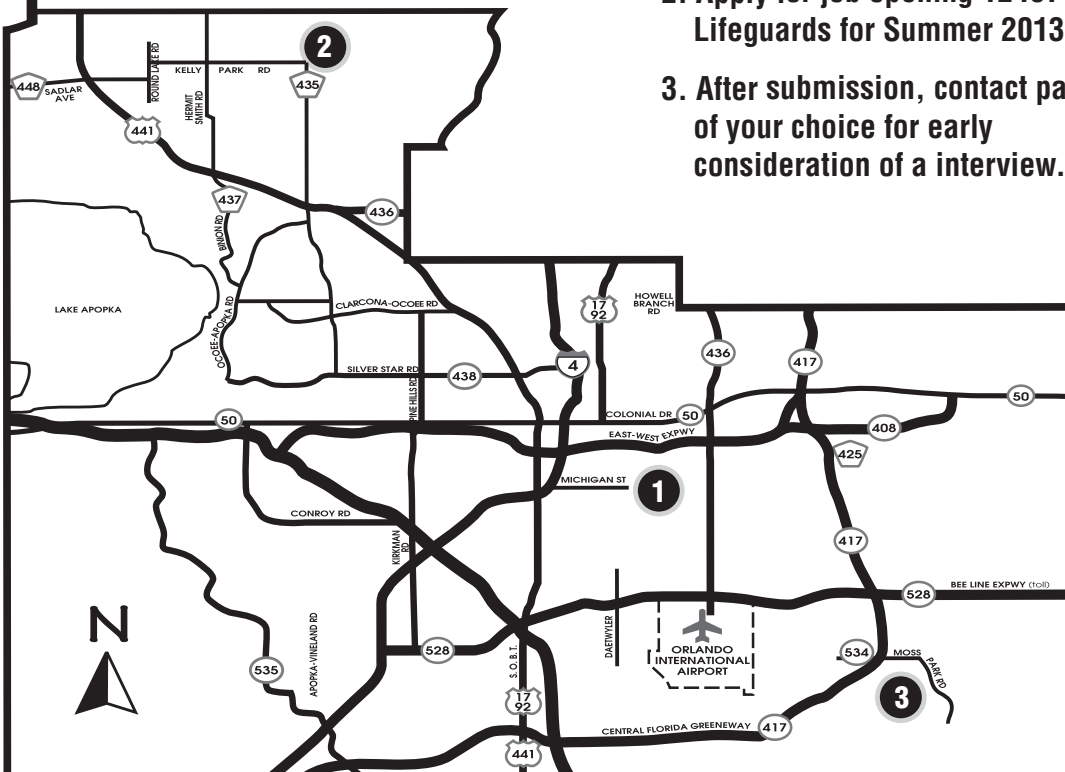

INTERVIEWS AND WATER TESTS CONDUCTED THAT NIGHT
Applicants must be at least 16 years of age.

Applicants must bring the following:

Student ID • Bathing Suit and Towel • Three Letters of Recommendation

Water Test Includes:

1. **Swim 550 yards continuously, using these strokes:** either front crawl using rhythmic breathing and a stabilizing, propellant kick or breaststroke using a pull, breathe, kick and glide sequence
2. **Tread water for 2 minutes using only legs.** Candidates should place hands under the armpits.
3. **Timed Event** - Starting in the water, swim 20 yards using front crawl or breast stroke, surface dive 7–10 feet, retrieve a 10-pound object, return to the surface, swim 20 yards back to the starting point with the object and exit the water without using a ladder or steps **within 1 minute, 40 seconds.**
4. **Swim 5 yards;** submerge and retrieve 3 dive rings placed 5 yards apart in 4–7 feet of water; resurface; swim 5 yards to side of the swim area. Ensures the participants will have the underwater swimming and breath holding skills needed to learn the deep water search skills.
