History of Orange County Parks and Recreation

1924 - Orange County Parks and Recreation traces its beginnings to Wilbur and Rose Warren who donated 8 acres to Orange County to be utilized as a park.

Subsequently, several other parks were also donated: Kelly Park Rock Springs, Moss Park, Trimble Park, and Downey Park.

1973 - Orange County Parks and Recreation Department was officially established by the County Commission.

1985 - The focus of Parks and Recreation was changed to reflect the urbanizing County and expanded to include recreation programs.

2010 - Our mission is to provide quality parks and recreation for all.

Unmanned pocket parks and neighborhood parks will not change and will remain open from sunrise to sunset. Little league facilities will also remain open until 10:00 p.m.

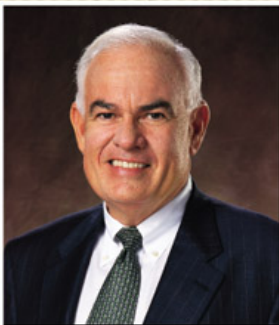

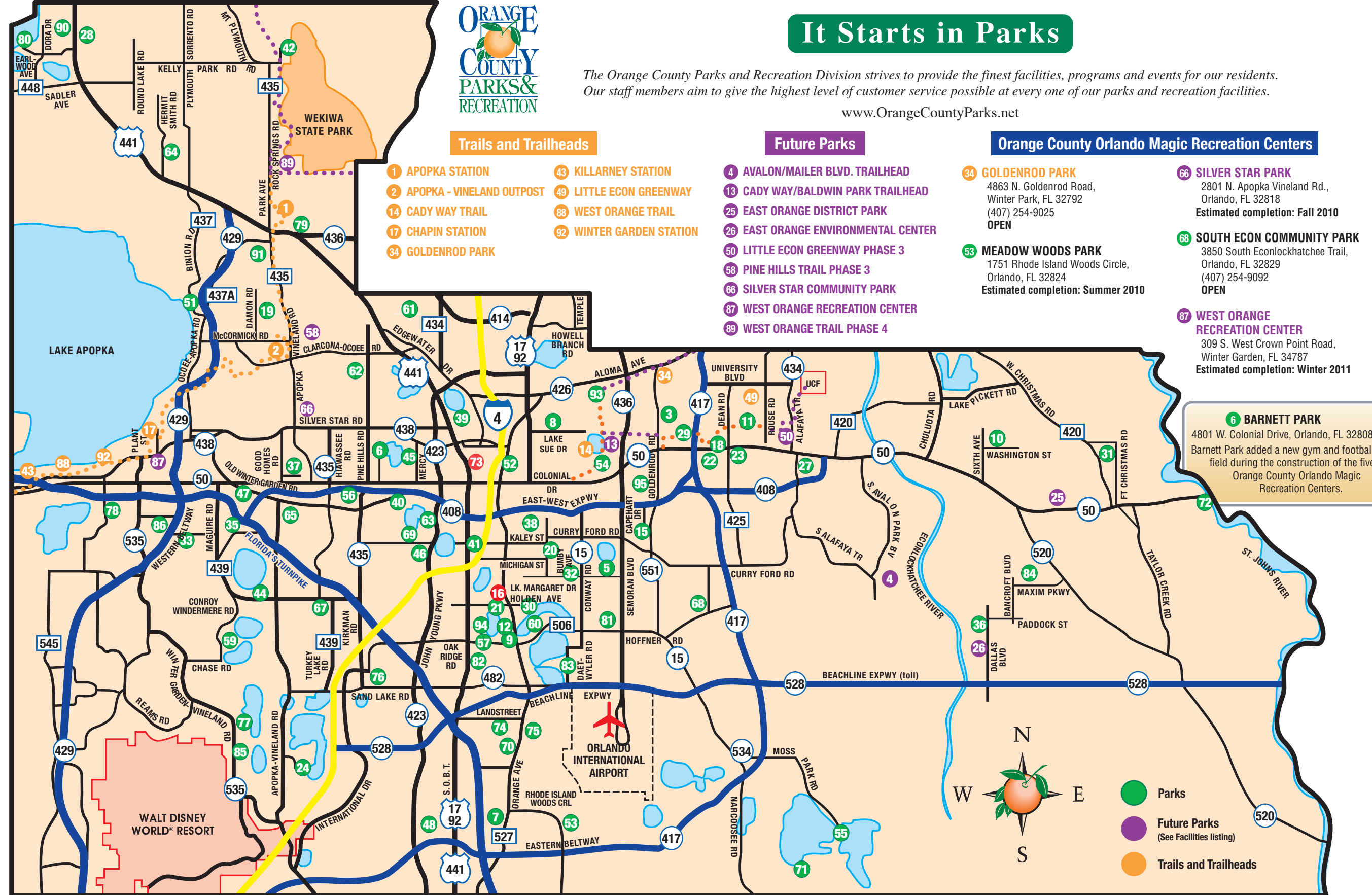
