#### ADDENDUM NO. 3

This Addendum is hereby incorporated into the request for proposal documents of the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions, and/or revisions to and shall be amended as follows.

<u>ADDITION:</u> SCOPE OF SERVICES; TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS, Section C, Contractor's Responsibilities; Add Paragraph 15, to read as follows.

#### 15. Background Check / Drug Screen

The Contractor shall submit a current (no more than 30 days old) completed Level 1 background check (on an annual basis) to the OCCC's designated Security Division representative for each employee that will perform onsite services under the contract, at the Contractor's expense, before performing any work. Clearance may be denied based on the results of the background check.

#### Level 1 (past five years) to include:

Identification Verification
Selective Service Status (registered/unregistered)
FDLE Automated Criminal Record
Clerk of Courts by County of Residence
Employment Verification
DMV by State of Residence
Military Service Verification
Professional License and Certification Check

#### **Drug Screen – Five Panel to include:**

Amphetamines
Cocaine Metabolites
Marijuana Metabolites
Opiate Metabolites
Phencyclidine

<u>ADDITION:</u> SCOPE OF SERVICES; TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS, Section C, Contractor's Responsibilities; Add Paragraph 16, to read as follows.

#### 16. Transition Plan/Schedule

The Contractor shall complete the transition within 120 days of date of contract execution. The transition shall include but not limited to installing of software to existing media players and ensure connectivity is achieved to each digital sign to control content.

**CORRECTION:** GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS; Section 5. <u>INSURANCE</u>, Required Coverage, Paragraph mentioning Business Automobile Liability is corrected to read as follows:

Business Automobile Liability - The Vendor/Contractor shall maintain coverage for all owned; non-owned and hired vehicles issued on the most recent version of the ISO form as filed for use in Florida or its equivalent, with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 (five hundred thousand dollars) (one million) per accident. In the event the Vendor/Contractor does not own automobiles the Vendor/Contractor shall maintain coverage for hired and non-owned auto liability, which may be satisfied by way of endorsement to the Commercial General Liability policy or separate Business Auto Liability policy.

**CORRECTION:** CONTRACT #19-1036-TJ; ARTICLE 4 <u>INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS</u>, Required Coverage, Paragraph mentioning Business Automobile Liability is corrected to read as follows:

Business Automobile Liability - The Vendor/Contractor shall maintain coverage for all owned; non-owned and hired vehicles issued on the most recent version of the ISO form as filed for use in Florida or its equivalent, with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 (five hundred thousand dollars) (one million) per accident. In the event the Vendor/Contractor does not own automobiles the Vendor/Contractor shall maintain coverage for hired and non-owned auto liability, which may be satisfied by way of endorsement to the Commercial General Liability policy or separate Business Auto Liability policy.

#### A. Questions and Answers

**Question 1:** Can you provide a full event schedule for 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022?

**Answer:** Yes. OCCC is only able to provide the full event schedule for the term April 2019-April 2021. See Attachment J, "Future OCCC Event Schedule".

**Question 2:** What is the current digital signage software? Also please provide as much detail about software as possible including when it was installed, the current version, number of licenses, add-ons etc.

**Answer**: The current digital software is a custom and unnamed software developed by a company called OSSI, a subcontractor to the current provider. It was installed approximately 6 years ago. The current version, number of licenses, and add-ons are unknown. The current digital advertising provider utilizes a subscription-based software that is proprietary to the current provider. OCCC does not own the digital signage software in place to be transferable to a new provider.

**Question 3:** Do we have to use the current digital signage software and hardware or can we replace?

Answer: The current digital signage software is proprietary to the current digital advertising provider. Regarding software, per Paragraph C(12)(A), the Contractor shall be responsible for "Content and Scheduling Software." Paragraph C(14) lists the minimum requirements of the software chosen and utilized by the Contractor. See response to Question #2 also. Regarding hardware, as stated in Scope of Services, Technical Requirements, Paragraph F(1), "Contractor may be engaged to perform proposed work (labor and materials) at cost plus 10% markup by issuance of a Delivery Order." Such proposed work, subject to approval by OCCC, may include upgrades, enhancements, and/or replacements of existing hardware by the Contractor. Additionally, Paragraph F(1) also allows for the Contractor, with OCCC approval, to "mobilize hardware on-site...to enhance the Digital Advertising Services program on a pilot or show/event basis...and be subject to the revenue distribution established by the Contractor."

**Question 4:** Could we receive sales projections by revenue category?

**Answer:** Yes. Sales projections, as provided by the current Contractor are for the next fiscal year only (Oct 2019-Sept 2020.) This projection totals \$492,700, and is listed by event as shown on the enclosed Attachment K, "Digital Advertising Sales Projections – Fiscal Year 2019/2020". Proposers are advised these are budgeted projections only and that actual revenues generated by the successful contractor may differ.

**Question 5:** Under section C of the technical requirements the RFP states, "The Contractor shall submit proposed advertising pricing for each show/event to the OCCC. The OCCC will have the final approval for advertising rates proposed to a given show client." If we provide the OCCC a standard price sheet, would that be acceptable?

**Answer:** A proposed standard price sheet, following approval by OCCC, is acceptable to be used as a normal standard by the Contractor, however any deviation of pricing to a given show client will require final approval by OCCC as specified in the solicitation.

**Question 6:** How will the OCCC handle all maintenance and operation of all digital displays and associated hardware components. Who at the OCCC will be responsible for digital signage maintenance and what is the process and timeline for maintenance request?

**Answer**: In Technical Requirements, Paragraph D(1), "Maintenance and operation of all digital displays and associated hardware components" applies to those owned by the OCCC. All maintenance and/or repairs on OCCC owned equipment shall be performed as quickly as feasible by OCCC or any contractors OCCC may select to perform maintenance requests of existing digital signage platforms (Gable, Epson and Samsung). The Contractor is solely responsible for maintenance and repairs to any displays and associated hardware components that the Contractor may rent or own, and that may be mobilized for a pilot or given event or show, with OCCC's approval.

**Question 7:** Who manages the OCCC's internal network infrastructure? Is digital signage on its own VLAN on the OCCC network? Is the OCCC's internal network infrastructure/digital signage network available throughout the facility including in event space and halls?

**Answer:** The existing locations for digital signage is on its own VLAN managed by the OCCC's Internet Service Provider. Any supplemental network infrastructure for digital signage locations (temporary or permanent) in events space and halls require approval by OCCC.

**Question 8:** Will the Contractor be provided office space, storage space and/or parking at the Orange County Convention Center?

**Answer:** Upon successful completion of drug screen and background checks, the Contractor shall be issued ID badge(s) and provided complimentary parking in the West Building garage for its first-line sales and/or management staff. Cubicle style workspace for 1-2 persons shall be provided onsite, at a location to be determined. A limited amount of storage space may be provided on an asneeded basis, subject to availability.

**Question 9:** Can you provide the current advertising pricing for OCCC **Answer:** Current revenue share for these services can be obtained from Procurement's Term Contracts webpage under contract number Y6-159. (http://apps.ocfl.net/OrangeBids/TermContracts/listtermcontract.asp)

**Question 10:** Who is the current static advertiser? Can the authority provide a copy of the contract? How is the DSN advertiser expected to work with them? **Answer:** All static and print advertisements are is handled internally by OCCC and little interaction with the awarded Digital Advertising Services provider is anticipated.

**Question 11:** Can the authority provide a copy of the contract with the existing DSN advertising provider?

**Answer:** The current digital advertising <u>provider</u> contract can be obtained from Procurement's <u>Term Contracts webpage</u> under contract number Y6-159: (http://apps.ocfl.net/OrangeBids/TermContracts/listtermcontract.asp)

**Question 12:** What is the preferred format for contract exceptions to be noted? **Answer:** Any exceptions to the standard contract must be clearly indicated by return of the standard contract with the proposal, with exceptions clearly noted. Exceptions can be noted on the draft contract by redline and proposed language changes or by submitting separate document clearly stating proposers exceptions to each area/clause of the contract and their proposed language.

**Question 13:** What is the date on which the contract is expected to commence? **Answer:** The contract is expected to commence in June/July 2019.

**Question 14:** Does the DSN currently display exclusively advertising content? Is the OCCC interested in signage that conveys convention and wayfinding information as well?

**Answer:** Yes. Currently, the DSN is the exclusive delivery application for digital advertising. No, wayfinding information is not included in the scope of this solicitation.

**Question 15:** Will the successful proposer be responsible for exclusively selling advertising for all events / conventions? Do the events / conventions have any pre-negotiated inventory?

**Answer:** Yes. The successful contractor shall be the exclusive provider for all advertising on the DSN, within all OCCC buildings, for all shows and events held at the OCCC. The DSN at the OCCC refers to advertising through the DSN via hard-wired connection or via internet drop by the OCCC's contracted Internet Service Provider, and displayed through the contracted Digital Advertising

Service Provider's content management software. As such, Contractor's sales for all digital advertising is subject to the revenue share under this contract. Yes, the events/conventions have pre-negotiated inventory. Any pre-negotiated advertisements shall be handled same as outlined in Scope of Services, Technical Requirements, Paragraph C(13). However, events/conventions may display their own advertising in their leased space and/or in public areas adjacent to leased space, but not through the DSN. Any pre-negotiated advertisements scheduled to be performed under the contract shall be transferred to the Contractor and handled similarly as outlined in Scope of Services, Technical Requirements, Paragraph C(13).

**Question 16:** Can the OCCC confirm that it will be responsible for all maintenance and needed repairs for the signage?

**Answer:** See response to Question 6.

**Question 17:** Does the OCCC own the existing DSN inventory or does the current digital ad vendor?

**Answer:** Existing digital advertising inventory is not owned by the OCCC. Existing displays and associated hardware components are owned by the OCCC. See Attachments B and D of the solicitation for details of the existing DSN inventory.

**Question 18:** Is the OCCC open to a contract of longer length?

**Answer:** No. The contract term shall remain as intended for a three-year initial contract term, with two (2) additional one-year renewal options.

**Question 19:** Do the existing wayfinding kiosks have digital advertising on them? Will the successful proposer be responsible for this inventory?

**Answer:** The existing wayfinding kiosks do not include digital advertising. Existing wayfinding kiosks are not included in the scope of this contract.

**Question 20:** Are there any existing client orders that will be in force at the start of the contract takeover?

**Answer:** See response to Question 15.

**Question 21:** Can the OCCC provide the exact number of digital signs currently in place? Does the OCCC have any plans to / is interested in expanding this network?

**Answer:** There are 40 current locations of existing digital signage as stated in the Background and Project Overview section of the solicitation and located per Attachment C. No. OCCC does not have other plans to increase the number of digital signage locations in process at this time.

**Question 22:** Is the OCCC interested in procuring interactive digital signage or additional wayfinding kiosks?

**Answer:** No, interactive signage and wayfinding kiosks are not included in the scope of this solicitation.

**Question 23:** Can the OCCC provide details on the current DSN hardware (i.e. physical dimensions and technical specifications, including manufacturer and model) and software (operating system, content management system, ad server/player)?

**Answer:** Regarding current DSN hardware, see Attachments B and D. Regarding current DSN software, see response to Question 2.

**Question 24:** Do the existing signs have wireless modems/connectivity? If so, what sort of connectivity do they have and who provides for it?

**Answer:** No. The existing signs do not have wireless modems/connectivity. All connectivity is through wired connection. The DSN network access shall be provided at no charge to the Digital Advertising Services Contractor through OCCC's Internet Service Provider.

**Question 25:** If the proposer does not plan to subcontract any portion of the work, is the 24% MBE goal still applicable?

**Answer:** The 24% MWBE goal is still applicable as it relates to subcontracting to a MWBE on this RFP. However, if the proposer does not plan to subcontract any portion of the work; then the 24% MWBE goal would not be achieved.

**Question 26:** How are ads currently delivered to the digital signs? Is it via the cloud or are ads manually loaded onto each sign?

**Answer:** Currently, digital advertisements are scheduled and delivered through the current provider's content management software. It is not via the cloud.

**Question 27:** Can the OCCC provide a list of the 25 largest advertisers per year (ideally with spend for each individual advertisers)?

**Answer:** Yes. See enclosed Attachment L, "Top 25 Digital Advertisers – By OCCC Event", for annual average by event, over the past 3 years.

**Question 28:** Can the OCCC clarify that none of the digital signs mounted on the concourse columns currently display advertising and are not available for advertising? Would the OCCC be interested in adding advertising capabilities?

**Answer:** Signage mounted on the concourse columns is not included in the scope of this solicitation.

**Question 29:** Would the OCCC consider a two-week extension of the deadline to allow adequate time for proposers to incorporate question answers into their offer?

**Answer:** See Addendum 2 of this solicitation.

**Question 30:** Whether companies from Outside USA can apply for this? (like, from India or Canada)

**Answer:** All companies submitting a response to this solicitation shall comply with the requirements specified in this RFP. The company shall be authorized to do business within the State of Florida.

Question 31: Whether proposers need to come over there for meetings?

**Answer:** The OCCC considers it crucial that the Contractor's sales staff is regularly available to meet with clients, during site visits, pre-planning meetings, consultative trips with OCCC staff, as well as to monitor the signs for accurate operation and display sequence. In addition, Contractor's staff are expected to be meeting with, and giving presentations to, local companies for supplemental advertising options.

**Question 32:** Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside USA? (Like, from India or Canada)

**Answer:** There may be task related to the RFP that may require a proposer's physical presence.

Question 33: Can we submit the proposals via email?

**Answer:** No. Proposers shall not submit proposals via email.

**Question 34**: Given the short timeline between the Q&A and the responses that impact answers have on [proposal] responses, would the OCCC consider a two-week extension?

Answer: See Addendum 2 of this solicitation.

**Question 35**: Section 1, Page 5, #13 Accounting: Since this is a revenue share contract, please explain why Orange County would need to know the Contractor's costs of goods and use of funds

**Answer**: This paragraph is included as a standard part of the solicitation boilerplate and has been approved by Legal. This clause exists for auditing purposes.

**Question 36**: Section 2, Page 3, #11: Does the hardware for temporary mobile displays have to be provided by the show manager client or by the contractor? **Answer**: Mobile displays not running through the DSN are not exclusive so either the show manager client or the Contractor may provide this. Although this is a business decision on behalf of the Contractor, it would be to the Contractor's financial advantage to provide the mobile display if also providing advertising for the show manager or their exhibitors/sponsors.

As per Scope, Technical Requirements, Paragraph F(2), "Contractor may, with the approval of OCCC, mobilize hardware on-site owned or rented by the Contractor to enhance...". While it is not specifically required as such, it is the intent that the Contractor for Digital Advertising Service would provide such hardware. Any hardware for temporary mobile displays that runs through the DSN via hard-wired connection or via internet drop by the OCCC's contracted Internet Service Provider, and displayed through the contracted Digital Advertising Service Provider's content management software would be subject to the revenue distribution as specified in the solicitation.

**Question 37**: What is the timeline for transition from the current provider to the new contractor?

**Answer**: The Transition Plan is a component of the Project/Technical Approach (Tab 3) that the Proposer should address in detail in the RFP submittal. Also see added Paragraph 16, <u>Transition Plan/Schedule</u> specified herein.

**Question 38**: Section 2, Page 4, #D(3) OCCC Responsibilities: Please clarify whether the Digital Signage Network will reside on the Orange County Convention Center's internal network, or reside on the Smart City Events Network?

**Answer**: The digital signage network will reside on its own VLAN managed by the OCCC's contracted Internet Service Provider.

**Question 39**: Section 3, Page 5, #E: Are there any restrictions imposed by show management regarding the sale of advertising directly to exhibitors or sponsors without their approval?

**Answer**: Yes, there are restrictions. The Contractor is not permitted to solicit exhibitors or sponsors without show management approval.

**Question 40**: Section 3, Page 5, #E: Please provide current advertising pricing for the national, regional and local (NRL) clients.

**Answer**: See Attachment M, "Digital Advertising Rates: National, Regional and Local." Rates are per year. Shorter periods are not typically offered and require specific OCCC approval.

**Question 41**: Section 3, Page 5, #E: How many staff members are currently selling to NRL clients?

**Answer**: Currently, there is one (1) staff member (OCCC employee) selling to NRL clients.

**Question 42**: Section 3, Page 5, #E: Are there any restrictions on the sale or running content of the NRL clients?

**Answer**: Yes. OCCC may review the playlist and request rearrangement if requested by the client due to any conflicts with NRL advertisements versus Client's playlist. If client purchases a complete buyout OCCC will remove all NRL advertisements for the duration of the applicable show days.

**Question 43**: Section 3, Page 5, #E: Please provide the last three years' worth of revenue from advertising sales for NRL clients.

**Answer**: See Attachment N, "Digital Advertising Revenue – NRL Clients".

**Question 44**: Section 3, Page 5, #E: Does OCCC have long-term contracts in place for NRL clients that would need to be honored?

**Answer**: Currently, there are 7 NRL agreements that extend beyond the anticipated start date of the new contract and those shall be transferred to the newly awarded contractor.
