This addendum is hereby incorporated into the bid documents of the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions and/or revisions to and shall take precedence over the original documents. Additions are indicated by <u>underlining</u>, deletions are indicated by <u>strikethrough</u>.

THE BID OPENING DATE REMAINS UNCHANGED.

- 1. The following represents a change to the IFB.
 - **A.** Regarding Part G, Paragraph 11-C, REVISE all references of "St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD)" to read, "South Florida Water management District (SFWMD)" This revision applies also to Part G, Permits Sub-paragraph 1, and any other applicable reference in the solicitation.
- 2. The following are responses to bidder questions.

Question 1: In the Plans on page 2 under Stormwater Pay Items Notes, paragraph 1, 101-1 Mobilization it states: The lump sum price also shall include all costs for furnishing, installing, <u>relocating and removing the project signs</u>. Is a Project Sign required, or are there specific signs that this is referring to?

Response: The Contractor's MOT plan shall adhere to FDOT Standard Spec 102 and include anything that is deemed necessary for approval by the County.

Question 2: Item 430-94-3 Desilting Pipe, 42" - Is the County requiring video verification after the desilting of pipe?

Response: Yes, see Spec 430-4.8 Final Pipe Inspection and 430-4.8.1 Video report.

Question 3: Item 430-175-142 Concrete Pipe Culvert, RCP, Class III (42") - Is the County requiring laser profiling for the new 42" RCP pipe?

Response: The County does not require laser profiling.

Question 4: Regarding Item 430-94-3 Desilting Pipe 42"- access for desilting the pipe; Will the County clean the ditch in front of the mitered end section prior to construction?

Response: The County will clean the ditch area that if needs to complete the desilting of the pipe.

Question 5: Is the mitered end section accessible between the two homes northeast of the pond?

Response: The existing 42" pipe is located in the County rights of way.

- 3. All other terms, conditions and specifications remain the same.
- 4. a. The Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum by completing the applicable section in the solicitation or by completion of the acknowledgement information on the addendum.
