Items 64- TWILL MATTRESS COVER

Specifications are as follows: Slip-on style pillow case, minimum 7 1/4 oz. twill, approximately 65% polyester/35% cotton and approximately 30"x75"x4". Minimum colors are brown. Per dozen.

Item 65 - PILLOW CASE:

Specifications are as follows: Percale polyester cotton blend, white or unbleached only, minimum 19" x 27", slight irregular, minimum thread count of 180. Per dozen.

Item 66- BLANKET:

Specifications are as follows: 100% <u>polyester</u>, standard grade, size from approximately 66" x 90" through 72" x 90", preshrunk, minimum weight 2.5 pounds each, non-allergenic, **gray only**.

Item 67- FLAT SHEET:

Tear resistant, bacteria resistant, waterproof, wipe cleancapability, approximately 30" x 75" x 4". Mattress bid shall meet or exceed all criteria required in the above paragraph and the following tests: ASTM E906 (RHR), California Technical Bulletin 121, Federal Aviation Administration, ASTM E-162 Radiant Panel, ASTM E-662 Smoke Density.

Item 71- VINYL MATTRESS COVER:

Specifications are as follows: Slip-on pillow case style, flame retardant, minimum 12 oz. vinyl Staph-Chek or equal, Grade B, approximately 32" x 76" x 4". Required color is green.

Item 72 - PILLOW:

Specifications are as follows: Staph-Chek vinyl covered, polyester core pillows. Closure edge shall be folded over twice and double stitched. Flame resistant core of 100%, polyester. Flame resistant breathable vinyl cover, capable of wiping clean with soap and water, approximately 18" x 25", minimum 1.7 pounds, tear resistant, anti-bacterial, non-allergenic, self deodorizing.
