THE OPENING DATE IS July 2, 2019

This addendum is hereby incorporated into the bid documents of the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions and/or revisions to, and shall take precedence over, the original documents. Underlining indicates additions, deletions are indicated by ~~strikethrough~~.

- A. The RFI Opening Date remains July 2, 2019
- B. The following are questions/responses/clarifications:

1. Question: We are very interested in responding to the County's Public-Private Partnership, RFI # Y19-626-RM. We definitely want to attend the Market Sounding Event, however, several senior managers have conflicts that week and prices of hotels and flights are increased due to the fact that the meeting is on a Friday during high season. For these reasons, I submit the following question regarding RFI # Y19-626-RM. Would it be possible to change the date of the Market Sounding Event from a Friday, July 26, to possibly the following week or later?

Response: While the County is sensitive to the scheduling challenges for potential attendees, the Market Sounding Event will be held on Friday, July 26th. The County encourages thoughtful responses to the RFI, regardless of attendance at the Market Sounding. The County plans to record the event and make this information available after the meeting.

2. Question: How are the recyclables currently taken to the MRF facilities located 40-100 miles away? Bales, not compacted, etc....? We would like to reduce transportation as much as possible to reduce environmental impacts, road degradation, and overall costs for the operation.

Response: Recyclables currently are loose loaded into open-top transfer trailers and driven to off-site processing locations. The County is interested in obtaining information concerning options for processing or hauling recyclables and welcomes all ideas in RFI responses.

3. Question: Will the awardee be responsible for the recyclables during the time the MRF is being built/redesigned?

Response: The County has made no decision concerning this issue. The RFI specifically asks respondents to, "Suggest how recycling can be accommodated during a transition period between awarding a new contract and initial operation of a renovated or new MRF." The County is interested in obtaining information concerning options for managing recyclables during the transition period from the current processing approach to a new processing approach and welcomes all ideas in RFI responses.

4. Question: As responses are limited to 15 pages, we wanted to inquire if the Form on the County's RFI page 13 and a Table of Contents would be counted in the 15 page max.

Response: Required forms are not counted as part of the encouraged page limitation. Respondents may include supplemental information as an attachment as described in the RFI.

- C. All other terms and conditions of the RFP remain the same.
- D. The Proposer shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum by completing the applicable section in the solicitation or by completion of the acknowledgement information on the addendum. Either form of acknowledgement must be completed and returned not later than the date and time for receipt of the proposal.
