RIO PINAR LAKES FORCE MAIN IMPROVEMENTS

REVISED BID OPENING DATE: June 11, 2019 JUNE 18, 2019

This Addendum is hereby incorporated into the bid documents of the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions and/or revisions to and shall take precedence over the original documents. Additions are indicated by <u>underlining</u>, deletions are indicated by <u>strikethrough</u>.

A. BID OPENING DATE IS CHANGED FROM JUNE 11, 2019 TO JUNE 18, 2019 AT 2:00 P.M.

B. CLARIFICATIONS

1. Q: Is the road closure for Palm Creek Ave. approved with Public Works for the jack and bore?

A: As stated in General Note No. 39; Sheet U-101, Note No. 3; and within Specification Section 01010, *Summary of Work*, Orange County Public Works has provided preliminary approval for the closure of Palm Creek Ave. between Curry Ford Rd. and Altavan Ave. for construction of the bore and jack. The Contactor is required to prepare and submit a maintenance of traffic plan to OCPW. Palm Creek Ave. cannot be closed without an approved MOT Plan. At a minimum, variable message boards and detour route signage will be required as part of the MOT Plan.

2. Q: Due to the small amount of soil cement can we substitute with crushed concrete or limerock or 8" concrete base?

A: The project shall be bid in accordance with the Construction Drawings and Specifications. The selected Contractor may propose a change of materials after award of the Contract in accordance with the terms and conditions of the bid.

3. Q: The plans show 4 sample collection joints to the Owner but the bid sheet only has 2?

A: There is an error in the Bid Schedule. The correct quantity for Bid Item No. 29, *Sample Collection for Pipelines (Joints to Owner)* is "4". The Bid Schedule will be reissued with this Addendum.

4. Q: Can a line item be added for the replacement of underdrain?

A: Removal and replacement of underdrain is paid for under Specification Section 01025 *Measurement and Payment*, Bid Items 31-33.

5. Q: Can a line item be added for the replacement of striping?

A: Pavement markings, both temporary and permanent as required by Orange County Public Works, are included under Specification Section 01025 *Measurement and Payment*, Bid Items 11-13.

6. Q: Per the sequence of work can you please show a detail where the line stop and cap at Station 79+41?

A: There is an error on the "Sequence of Work", sheet G-103. The referenced Line Stop and Cap are at Station 75+14.

7. Q: Can you please provide some more clarification on the sequence of work in relation to each lift station and bypassing?

A: During the Phase 1 Work, PS #3266 and PS #10821 will continue to pump wastewater to the North as they currently operate. Upon completion of the proposed force main from Curry Ford Road to PS #3266, PS #3266 discharge piping will be removed from the existing force main and connected to the newly completed proposed force main (redirecting the wastewater flow to the South), Phase 2 Work. Adequate primary and backup bypass equipment to maintain service as described in Specification Section 01516 - Collection System Bypass is required. Upon completion of the proposed force main from PS #3266 to PS #10821, PS #10821 discharge piping will be removed from the existing force main and connected to the newly completed proposed force main (redirecting the wastewater flow to the South), Phase 3 Work. Adequate primary and backup bypass equipment to maintain service as described in Specification Section 01516 - Collection System Bypass is required. In accordance with Project General Note No. 25, the shutdown shall be coordinated with the County representative a minimum of 7 days prior to the shutdown.

8. Q: Do both sections need to be approved by DEP since one is a line replacement?

A: Yes, the entire 4,000 feet of proposed force main must be cleared for use by FDEP. We anticipate this project requiring two (2) FDEP Clearances, a Partial Clearance and a Final Clearance. Additionally, the replacement segment has been increased from a 6-inch FM to a 12-inch FM.

9. Q: Is a Project Identification Sign required for this project? If so, how many?

- A: Project identification signs are required for this project per Specification Section 01580 – *Project Identification and Signs*. In accordance with section 1.03, linear projects require signs at each end of the work. Therefore, a minimum of two (2) signs shall be required, one at each end of the work zone on Palm Creek Ave. and on Rio Pinar Lakes Boulevard.
- 10. Q: As we are planning to bid this project under Utility Systems Construction, LLC, will we be able to utilize our experience for projects done under PWC Joint Venture? Please note, PWC Joint Venture is comprised of PWC and Utility Systems Construction, LLC.
 - A: The bidder may submit previous successful project experience completed as part of a Joint Venture for previous successful project experience submitted for a member of the Joint Venture team. It is the Contractor's responsibility to make it clear on the submission that work was completed as part of a Joint Venture and that the Construction Firm submitting the work experience was the construction firm that constructed the reference element. It is also the Contractor's responsibility to notify the provided references of the work experience the Contractor is submitting. The previous successful project experience must be verifiable.

11. Q: Are we required to follow the Sequence of Work exactly as described?

A: No, the "Sequence of Work" is a general construction guideline. The awarded Contractor may propose any work sequence he chooses. A Progress Schedule depicting the approach to prosecution and completion of the Work is required in accordance with Specification Section 01310 *Progress Schedules*.

12. Q: Is the cost for sod replacement included within the cost of constructing the force main or as a separate bid item?

A: The cost of labor and materials for replacing sodding to be included with construction of the force main. Specification Section 01025 *Measurement and Payment* and the Bid Schedule are revised and reissued with this Addendum.

MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 REQUIREMENTS INCLUDED

- A. This Section specifies administrative and procedural requirements to define pay items and determine payable amounts, and includes but is not limited to:
 - 1. General Provisions
 - 2. Cash Allowances
 - 3. Work Not Paid for Separately
 - 4. Measurement for Payment
 - 5. Partial Payment for Stored Materials and Equipment

1.02 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A. This specification includes standard descriptions for all bid items. This Contract's specific bid items are listed in the Bid Schedule.
- B. The total Contract Amount shall cover the Work required by the Contract Documents. All costs in connection with the successful completion of the Work, including furnishing all materials, equipment, supplies, and appurtenances; providing all construction, equipment, and tools; and performing all necessary labor and supervision to fully complete the Work, shall be included in the unit and lump sum prices bid. All Work not specifically set forth as a pay item in the Bid Form shall be considered a subsidiary obligation of the Contractor and all costs in connection therewith shall be included in the prices bid.
- C. If used, all estimated quantities stipulated in the Bid Schedule or other Contract Documents are approximate and are to be used only (a) for the purpose of comparing the bids submitted for the Work, and (b) as a basis for determining an initial Contract Amount. The actual amounts of Work completed and materials furnished under unit price items may differ from the estimated quantities. The County does not expressly or by implication represent that the actual quantities involved will correspond exactly to the quantities stated in the Bid Schedule; nor shall the Contractor plead misunderstanding or deception because of such estimate or quantities or of the character, location or other conditions pertaining to the Work. Payment to the Contractor will be made only for the actual quantities of work performed or material furnished in accordance with the Drawings and other Contract Documents, and it is understood that the quantities may be increased or decreased as provided in the General Conditions.

- D. If used, the unit prices listed in the Bid Schedule shall include all services, obligations, responsibilities, labor, materials, devices, equipment, royalties and license fees, supervision, temporary facilities, construction equipment, bonds, insurance, taxes, clean up, traffic control, control surveys, field offices, close out, overhead and profit and all connections, appurtenances and any other incidental items of any kind or nature, as are necessary to complete the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents.
- E. Except for mobilization/demobilization and project record documents, payment for Work will be based on the percent of completed work of each item in the Schedule of Values, including stored materials, as determined by the County. Progress of work in each item of the Schedule of Values will be determined separately by the County. However, the County will issue a single payment certificate for progress on the Contract.
- F. The Contractor agrees that it will make no claim for damages, anticipated profits, or otherwise because of any difference between the amounts of work actually performed and materials actually furnished and the estimated amounts therefore.
- G. Where payment by scale weight is specified under certain items, the Contractor shall provide suitable weighing equipment which shall be kept in accurate adjustment at all times and certified. The weighing of all material shall be performed by the Contractor in the presence and under the supervision of the County.
- H. All schedules included in the Contract Documents are given for convenience and are not guaranteed to be complete. The Contractor shall assume all responsibility for the making of estimates of the size, kind, and quantity of materials and equipment included in work to be done under this Contract.
- I. Where pipe fittings are noted on the Drawings, such notation is for the Contractor's convenience and does not relieve the Contractor from laying and jointing different or additional items where required.
- J. All contracts shall be subject to 10% minimum retainage as defined in the General Conditions and the Agreement.

K.

1.03 WORK NOT PAID FOR SEPARATELY

- A. Delivery: Payment for equipment delivery, storage or freight shall be included in the pay items including their installation and no other separate payment will be made therefore.
- B. Bonds: Payment for bonds required by the Contract shall be included in the pay items for the Work covered by the required bonds and no separate payment will be made.
- C. Preparation of Site: Payment for preparation of site shall be included in pay items proposed for the various items of Work and no separate payment will be made therefore. Preparation of site includes setting up construction plant, offices, shops, storage areas, sanitary and other facilities required by the specifications or state law or regulations;

providing access to the site; obtaining necessary permits and licenses; payments of fees; general protection, temporary heat and utilities including electrical power; providing shop and working drawings, certificates and schedules; providing required insurance; preconstruction photographs and videos; clearing and grubbing; removal of existing pavements, sidewalks and curbs; trench excavation, sheeting, shoring and bracing; dewatering and disposal of surplus water; structural fill, backfill, compaction and grading; testing materials and apparatus; maintenance of drainage systems; appurtenant work; record drawing and close-out documentation; cleaning up; and all other work regardless of its nature which may not be specifically referred to in a Bid Item but is necessary for the complete construction of the project set forth by the Contract.

- D. Permitting & Permit Fees.
- E. The County reserves the right to delete any item included in the Schedule of Values and decrease the Contract Price by the scheduled amount for the item deleted.

1.04 MEASUREMENT FOR PAYMENT

- A. Methods of Measurement Generally:
 - 1. Units of measurement shall be defined in general terms as follows:
 - a. Linear Feet (LF)
 - b. Square Feet (SF)
 - c. Square Yards (SY)
 - d. Cubic Yards (CY)
 - e. Each (EA)
 - f. Sacks (SK)
 - g. Lump Sum (LS)
 - 2. Unit Price Contracts/Items:
 - a. Linear Feet (LF) shall be measured along the horizontal length of the centerline of the installed material, unless otherwise specified. Pipe shall be measured along the length of the completed pipeline, regardless of the type of joint required, without deduction for the length of valves or fittings. Pipe included within the limits of lump sum items will not be measured.
 - b. Square Feet (SF), Square Yards (SY), Cubic Yards (CY), Each (EA) and Sacks (SK) shall be measured as the amount of the unit of measure installed and compacted within the limits specified and shown in the Specifications and Drawings. Slope angles and elevations shall be measured using land-surveying equipment. Contractor shall provide supporting documentation (i.e. drawings, delivery tickets, invoices, survey calculations, etc.) to verify actual installed quantities.
- B. Lump Sum Contracts/Items Generally:
 - 1. Quantities provided in the Schedule of Values are for the purpose of estimating the completion status for progress payments. Payment will be made for each individual item on a percentage of completion basis as estimated by the Contractor and approved by the County.
 - 2. Adjustments to costs provided in the accepted Schedule of Values may be made only by Change Order.

3. The County reserves the right to delete any item included in the Schedule of Values and decrease the Contract Price by the scheduled amount for the item deleted.

1.05 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT ITEMS

- A. *Only those bid items included in the Bid Schedule are applicable for this Contract*. The County has standardized the measurement and payment items. Currently, there are approximately 100 measurement and payment items describing approximately 300 bid items. The bid item numbering system comprises five sections that are divided into 23 subsections. The sections and subsections are listed below.

All of the subsections have bid item measurement and payment descriptions. - 1. All of the bid items in the Project Bid Schedule have 8 numerical digits.
- 2. Table A, "Measurement and Payment Items" for each of the bid items there are five

numerical digits followed by ".xxx".

3. The first 5 numerical digits of the bid item in the Project Bid Schedule designate the measurement and payment item found in Table A, "Measurement and Payment Items."
