The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions and/or revisions to and shall take precedence over the original documents. Additions are indicated by <u>underlining</u>, deletions are indicated by strikethrough (<u>strikethrough</u>).

1. The Proposal Opening Date has changed as follows:

Delete: November 19, 2019 at 2:00 P.M.

Replace with: **December 3, 2019 at 2:00 P.M**.

2 Note the REVISION to Terms and Conditions, Section #8, Paragraphs A and D, MINORITY/WOMEN OWNED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE as follows:

MINORITY/WOMEN OWNED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE:

- A. Proposers must address how they intend to comply with the Orange County M/WBE Ordinance, No. 94-02 and amended by Ordinance No. 2009-21. The goal of certified minority/women business enterprise is 27% of the contract value for this project. The Ordinance also addresses minority/women group employment levels setting goals to encourage each Proposer to maintain 24 18% minority and 6 % women employee workforce levels in specific categories.
- D. The County has established a credit program whereby Proposers are awarded credits to be applied toward meeting the M/WBE goals on certain County projects. Emphasis will be placed on credits for non-County utilization and first-time M/WBE utilization. Proposers are encouraged to contact the Business Development Division for information on acquiring and applying the credits.

- 3. The following are responses for request for information received.
- A. **Question**: Is there a minimum percentage required for a sub to qualify for veteran-owned extra points?

<u>Answer</u>: There is no minimum percentage required to qualify Registered SDV's for extra points. Percentages must be designated in a whole number (e.g. 5%). Expressions written such as +5%,>5% is not acceptable. See pages 9-10: Bonus Points For Hiring Registered Services—Disabled Veterans (A-F) for addition information.

B. **Question**: Can the same firm be used in both MBE and Veterans categories if The percentages are not overlapping? For example, if a proposer used a certified MBE for 15% M/WBE participation and also used the same certified MBE who is registered a SDV firm for 5%.

<u>Answer</u>: A firm that is a registered SDV and a certified Orange County MWBE can be used to provide a scope(s) of services for both categories. Certified MWBE's and Registered SDV's are scored separately therefore the percentages will not overlap.

- Percentages for MWBE will go towards the MWBE 27% goal.
- SDV receiving 5% will receive 2 points.
- 4. All other items, conditions and specifications remain the same.
- 5. The Proposer shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum by completing the applicable section in the solicitation or by completion of the acknowledgement iinformation on the addendum. Either form of acknowledgement must be completed and returned not later than the date and time for receipt of the proposal.
