I. Call to Order

With a quorum present, Dr. Elizabeth Nelson called the meeting of the Lake Conway Water and Navigation Control District Advisory Board (Advisory Board) to order at 6:42 p.m.

II. Approval of the November 10, 2020 Meeting Minutes

Upon a motion by Micky Blackton, seconded by Bobby Lance, and carried with all present members voting AYE by voice vote; the Advisory Board approved the November 10, 2020 meeting minutes.

III. Public Comment on Propositions before the Advisory Board

There was no public comment. An EPD conference room was made available to the public. No members of the public attended the meeting at the EPD conference room and no public comment cards were received (via email, mail, or fax) prior to the meeting.

IV. Comments of the Chair

Chair Dr. Nelson stated the advisory board has a busy agenda, and will have to work efficiently to cover all the topics.

V. Orange County EPD Report

Aquatic Plant Management Update

Ms. Urbanik stated the County had the opportunity to meet with Ed Harris, FWC, on the Conway Chain and review the aquatic plant concerns. Based on the inspection, Illinois pondweed (*Potamogeton illinoensis*) is not causing a navigation concern within the Chain of Lakes. Dense pondweed is growing close to the shoreline, and lakefront property owners can contact the County and FWC for permit information to clear an access corridor to access open water. Mr. Harris offered for anyone to contact him directly with specific FWC questions.

Advisory Board Project Prioritization List

Ms. Urbanik discussed the Advisory Board Project Prioritization List that was complete in April 2018. Discussion ensued. The results of the project prioritization will be presented at the next meeting.

Lake Gatlin Alum Treatment Proposal Update

The alum treatment proposal from Environmental Research and Design, Inc. was discussed.

Upon a motion by John Evertsen, seconded by Micky Blackton, and carried with all present members voting AYE by voice vote; the Advisory Board approved the Lake Gatlin Alum Treatment Proposal at a maximum cost of \$122,192.00.

Canal Sedimentation Analysis Scope

The three scopes for the Canal Sedimentation and Analysis were discussed.

Upon a motion by John Evertsen, seconded by Frances Guthrie, and carried with all present members voting AYE by voice vote; the Advisory Board approved the Proposal for Lake Conway Canal Siltation Study, by Geosyntec Consultants, Inc., the lowest bidder, at a cost of \$29,970.99.

John Evertsen requested Geosyntec Consultants, Inc. to include language in the final report of the estimated maximum depth of vessel draft for each canal.

Lake Conway Stormwater Study Project Update

Ms. Urbanik provided a list of current projects funded by the Lake Conway taxing district and proposed water quality projects. Discussion ensued. The Advisory Board requested to hold a special working meeting with the Advisory Board and the County, in the County Commissioner's Chambers, to go over the proposed list of water quality projects. Ms. Urbanik stated she will look into the request.

VI. Marine Patrol Report

Corporal Lowers presented the marine patrol report. For the month of December 2020, the following activities were reported:

- 315 vessels observed on the lake
- 2 vessel citations
- 15 vessel warnings
- 11 vessel inspections

David Woods presented his water elevation report.
