1. It appears this road is about 2,600 ft.long taking approximately 2,000 tons of asphalt to build. Was it the intention to set the experience threshold of 3,000 tons at a level that is 50% higher than the tonnage needed on this job?

## 28. REFERENCES:

Bidder should supply (with the bid form) a list of five (5) similar projects successfully completed **by the Bidder, as a Prime or Sub Contractor** within the last ten (10) years, immediately preceding the due date of bids for this Invitation for Bids. <u>The</u> <u>Contractor may also use their subcontractor to demonstrate experience for this</u> requirement. However, the subcontractor must be listed on Attachment C-2 of Part D, PRIME CONTRACTOR/SUBCONTRACTOR/SUPPLIER <u>INFORMATION and the project shall be submitted on Attachment E of the</u> <u>IFB to include all required information</u>. Contractor or their subcontractor experience shall demonstrate that the following elements were successfully completed. Failure to provide this information may be cause for rejection of the bid. For the purposes of the Invitation for Bids, a similar project is described as follows:

3 projects that include the placement of a minimum of <u>2,000</u> TN asphalt.

2 projects that include the construction of a concrete box culvert

Projects submitted should contain the following elements, this elements can be demonstrated among several projects and is not required to all be in a single project

A. Demolition and Removal of Existing Roadway

B. Construction of improved access road and Installation of various stormwater culverts, pipes and structures along the length of road improvement.

C. <u>The General and Sub cannot add (or combined) each of their experiences to</u> <u>obtain 2,000 tons minimum requirement.</u>

2. Is this to be intercepted as 3 projects ,each with 3000 TN of material (9000 tons of asphalt placement) and if so, can the prime contractor bidding be allowed to utilize a subcontractor's qualifications to meet this requirement?

**RESPONSE:** Please see the answer to question# 1.

C. All other term and conditions of the IFB remain the same.
