ORANGE COUNTY CLASS III LANDFILL ACCESS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS BID OPENING DATE: August 1, 2019

This addendum is hereby incorporated into the bid documents of the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions, and/or revisions to and shall take precedence over the original documents. Additions are indicated by <u>underlining</u>; deletions are indicated by <u>strikethrough</u>.

- A. The bid opening date remains August 1, 2019
- B. The following are questions/responses/clarifications:
 - **1.** Please expand on the Asphalt Milling storage area. Is this for the contractor's use?

RESPONSE: Millings from the Phase I project area shall be transported by the Contractor to the Asphalt Milling Storage Area.

2. Can the installation of 60" Storm drainage or larger satisfy the requirements for box culvert installation? These box culverts (6' x 4') are not any more difficult than large diameter and deep drainage installation.

RESPONSE: Please see revised C-15 paragraph 30 and attachment E

Bidder should supply (with the bid form) a list of five (5) similar projects successfully completed by the Bidder, as a Prime or Sub Contractor within the last ten (10) years, immediately preceding the due date of bids for this Invitation for Bids. The Contractor may also use their subcontractor to demonstrate experience for this requirement. However, the subcontractor must be listed on Attachment C-2 of Part D, PRIME CONTRACTOR/SUBCONTRACTOR/SUPPLIER INFORMATION and the project shall be submitted on Attachment E of the IFB to include all required information. Contractor or their subcontractor experience shall demonstrate that the following elements were successfully completed. Failure to provide this information may be cause for rejection of the bid. For the purposes of the Invitation for Bids, a similar project is described as follows:

- 3 projects that include the placement of a minimum of 2,000 TN asphalt.
- 2 projects that include the construction of a concrete box culvert

Projects submitted should contain the following elements, this elements can be demonstrated among several projects and is not required to all be in a single project

- A. Demolition and Removal of Existing Roadway
- B. Construction of improved access road and Installation of various stormwater culverts, pipes and structures along the length of road improvement.

- C. The General and Sub cannot add (or combined) each of their experiences to obtain 2,000 tons minimum requirement.
- D. <u>60" RCP drainage pipe or larger must include dewatering and construction of</u> associated CIP concrete headwall.

Qualifying projects may include either of the above options or combination of the two.

C. All other term and conditions of the IFB remain the same.

The Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum by completing the applicable section in the solicitation or by completion of the acknowledgement information on the addendum. Either form of acknowledgement must be completed and returned not later than the date and time for receipt of the bid.
